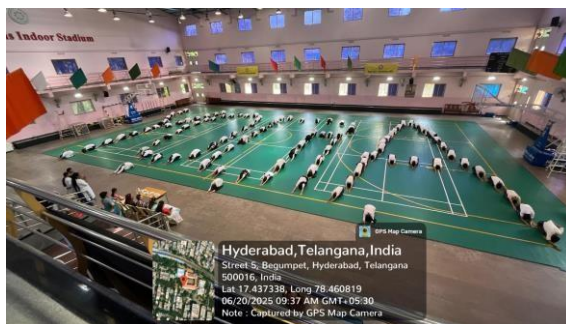
### 1. International Day of Yoga

## **8. Awareness program - Women's Day Celebration**

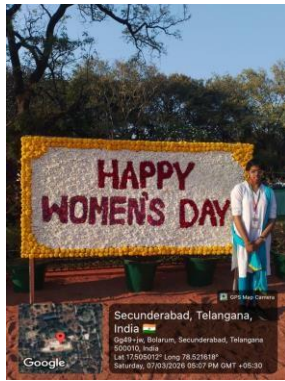
**DATE:**07-03-2026
