About the College

St. Francis College, founded in 1959 with the mission of providing holistic education to women students, is an autonomous college affiliated to Osmania University. The College was awarded CPE status in 2004 by UGC. The College offers UG and PG courses in the faculties of Arts, Science, Commerce, and Management Courses. The College has autonomy at both UG and PG level and has Choice Based Credit System. Department of Botany

At St. Francis College for Women with its inception in 1959 the college went on to introduce in 1962 a degree course with Botany, Zoology and Chemistry with the able guidance of Mrs. Leela Simon. The course has been instrumental in developing scientific interest amongst students and comprehends the significance of Fundamental Science in everyday life. As years rolled on new courses with Botany as a core were introduced namely Microbiology and Applied Nutrition.

Department of Environmental Studies

Environmental Science is a unique science of philosophy to be comprehended by everyone to conserve and restore the ecosystem. The genesis of the Department of Environmental Studies was in the year of 2005. It is an Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course, incorporated in the curriculum for all the streams of undergraduate students. This foundation course is intended to enrich the young minds with knowledge and understanding of the environment. Students are encouraged to acquire the skill to identify issues and propose sound concepts to address environmental concerns.

Department of Zoology

The Department of Zoology was established in the year 1962. The objective of the department is to impart quality education in the field of Zoology, offering skill based programs to motivate the students for self employment. The department organizes co-curricular activities for students every year in collaboration with various NGO's, Research Institutes and Academic bodies to make learning beyond the classroom and also arranges various Seminars, Workshops, Guest lectures, Field visits and Outreach programs.
