

NCC REPORT 2019-2020

The **National Cadet Corps** is a tri-services organization, comprising the Army, the Navy and the Air Force engaged in grooming the youth of the country into disciplined and patriotic citizens. NCC, given the vast benefits, opportunities and reservation, is the largest voluntary youth organization in the world. Every year, the cadets of St. Francis Degree College have won laurels by representing our state at National and International events.

The cadets have participated in various campaigns and activities to spread awareness on various social issues which has gained momentum in the right direction.

A few to mention are:

1. **Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat Camp**- 6 cadets from the Army Wing attended the EBSB Camp at Ghatkesar from 21st May to 1st June 2019.
2. **Ban plastic**- This program was carried out in Risala Bazaar and was organised by an NGO called Well Wishers Organisation on the 16th of June 2019. 25 cadets from our college participated in this campaign and carried out this awareness program.
3. **International Yoga Day**- 62 cadets from our college attended the International Yoga Day Celebrations on 26th June 2019. The program was organised by NCC DDG Air Cmdre N.N REDDY at Bison Polo Grounds.

6. **National Handloom Day**- To commemorate the Swadeshi Movement, the Prakiriti Club of our college organized an event in the Capitanio Hall on 2nd August, 2019. 50 cadets participated in the event.
7. **Helping Hands Humanity**- On 14th Aug, 2019 the NCC Cadets distributed old shoes and stationaries to the under privileged children.
